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Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Re: NAPLAN 2019

Please see attached the NAPLAN testing schedule for Years 7 and 9 students in 2019. Students will sit the tests with their class groups in the Library. The schedule has been set nationally so that tests are done within the same timeframe around the country. This year all tests will be conducted **online** and must be completed in nine days. The writing test has to be completed prior to doing any other tests. In the event of the online test not being able to be accessed, a paper test will be provided.

Students need to have the following items completed for all online tests:

- **Year 7s and 9s with BYODs only – your fully charged laptop computer** that has been approved to be used on our network, with the NAPLAN lockdown browser already installed. The lockdown browser can be installed via the KSHS NAPLAN 2019 Connect Library.
- **You must ensure you have paused the Windows updates until after NAPLAN.** There is a user guide available on the website and via our Facebook page to support you to do this.
- **Headphones for all Year 7 and 9 students.**
- Students who do not have their own device will have access to school laptops.

If paper testing is required all students will need – 2 x HB pencils, pencil sharpener, eraser and an approved scientific calculator. Please have this with you just in case.

There are some strict instructions for the test which need to be adhered to. These are listed below – please review these with your child prior to NAPLAN:

- Stay silent and quiet throughout the entire test.
- No one can leave before the time allocation has expired.
- Read everything and try to understand what the question asks.
- Answer and/or attempt all questions.
- If you have any general queries – raise your hand and wait until someone assists you.
- Visits to the toilet must be supervised so please ensure you go to the toilet before the test starts.
- Focus on your test the whole time, check your work at the end.

If testing conditions are compromised i.e. your child will not settle and is distracting others, then your child will be escorted to an alternative classroom to sit the test in isolation.

There are practice activities available on Connect in the KSHS NAPLAN 2019 library section. All students have access to this and students can access past NAPLAN papers to familiarise themselves with the layout and the types of questions asked. Answers and tips are also available through this Connect class. There is also tutoring being offered after school. Students are encouraged to access and utilize this support.

If students are absent they will be able to sit catch up tests only during the 9-day testing window. Students must see Mrs English before school on the day they return to school to arrange a catch up test.

Year 9 students who achieve Band 8 or higher will have met the standard required for Secondary Graduation and will not be required to sit further tests in Years 10-12 to meet this standard. It is important that all students work to the best of their ability during all NAPLAN tests.
