The successful students will be flown to Perth to attend the program at Curtin University during the first week of the school holidays. The program is led by experts in their field including Steve Swanson, two time NASA Astronaut and International Space Station (ISS) commander.

The students will work in teams to create science experiments that could be conducted in space. The overall winning team's experiment, as judged by the NASA panel, will be launched to the International Space Station and conducted by astronauts on board! Students will develop leadership, teamwork and public speaking skills. They will also learn about a range of exciting Space and Science career paths.
