The 2019 Yr. 11 Course Selection Guide is located on our website at [www.karrathashs.wa.edu.au](http://www.karrathashs.wa.edu.au). Commencing this year, students are required to complete their preferences via our online portal at <https://client.subjectselectiononline.com.au/?school=4422t>. Students must follow the instructions throughout the site and identify their chosen Academic Pathway to allow for choices to be made from the available subjects. Part of this process requires students and their parents/carers to book a time with one of our Course Counsellors to finalise this process.

Students still have the option of completing the Subject Selection Form in the Course Selection Guide manually and calling the school to arrange a Course Counselling appointment.

*Counselling will take place between 18 June and 3 August 2018.*

To login for the first time, use the forgotten password link, enter the email address supplied to the school upon enrolment of your child and you will receive an email stating your login code (Student Number) and a prompt to set your password.
